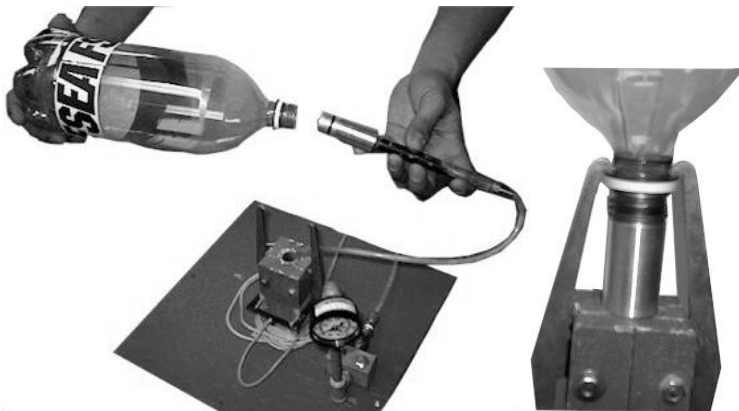




Rocket Launch Rules and Regulations:

All rockets must be made from plastic bottles, no metal or other hard objects can be used. The day of the competition, FSEA will provide materials for you to build a rocket. This material will be available on a first come first served basis and will consist of a limited number of bottles, plastic bags for parachutes, string, foam material for rocket fins and tape. It is strongly recommended that you bring a pre-built rocket to the competition, this will allow you more time to actually launch so that you can fine tune adjustments and have the best launch of the day. All rockets will be launched from the FSEA rocket launchers at the event. . The rockets will be pressurized to a maximum of 70 psi.



All launchers must wear safety goggles or glasses; these will be provided at the launch site. When you arrive at registration, you will pick up several launch tickets [click here for a sample](#); these must be filled out with all the required information and handed to the timer when you are setting up for your launch. Every timed launch will require a launch ticket. You may launch as many times as you have time for.
